

ASSESSMENT CENTRE

This is the first point of entry into the MES programme after outreach. The first step is the helpdesk at the Assessment Centre. If deemed necessary and based on the outcome the client is referred for further assessment. Once a client has gone through the intake phase, a multi-disciplinary team does a thorough assessment, after which a Care Plan is established in conjunction with the client. An Individual Development Plan (IDP) is then drawn up to ensure the implementation of the Care Plan. From the assessment, clients are referred to different services within the organisation as part of the intervention phase of the model. This is the first point of entry in order to empower individuals and families to have the necessary coping skills, which will enable them to function optimally and to develop their future potential.

SERVICES

- Offers a holistic view into individual's situation.
- Results in a Care Plan, and Individual Development Plan that is used to facilitate the individual's rehabilitation.
- Provision of food parcels, toiletries and clothing if a need is recognised.
- General Social Work Services.
- Child Protection Services.
- Family Preservation Services.

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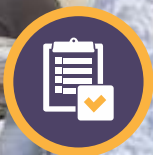
