The Social Work Programme assists homeless unemployed people in addressing their complex socio-economic and psychological problems by empowering them to develop their human potential and restore their dignity to live sustainably and independently.

OUR SERVICES

- Psychosocial assessment of all clients
- Developing individual development plans in conjunction with clients
- Monitoring through case conferences, panel discussions and case reviews
- Referring clients to other service providers for specific needs
- Counselling and case management
- Trauma debriefing
- Family reunification and reintegration services
- Soft skills training programmes
- Substance abuse support programmes
- Job placement
- Management of Residential Care
- Emergency accommodation: clients in crisis
